The financial support of the SSM provided me the chance to present my work about the generation and characterization of a fluorescent

influenza D reporter virus to the community and to discuss my findings with leading experts in the field. I had many interesting discussions about different strategies of introducing reporter genes into viral genomes and their stability over time and possible applications thereof with scientists employing different reporter viruses in their research. I enjoyed many fruitful discussions leading to new ideas for my project.
